Eligibility

All Students who have passed B.Sc. Chemistry or equivalent examination having <u>Chemistry subject</u>, are eligible to take admission for the M.Sc. I Chemistry course.

Admission Procedure

- 1) Interested students have to fill the Online registration form of M.Sc. Part I chemistry Admissions 2025-26 using the link below on or before Sunday, 29th June 2025 up to 12.00 (midnight).
- 2) A non-refundable fee of Rs. 500 must be paid while filling the registration form.
- 3) Students should fill the form completely & correctly, scan and upload all necessary documents. Note that only filling the Registration Form is not a guarantee to admission.
- 4) The applicant has to upload following documents at the time of filling Online registration form. (Documents should be clearly visible)
 - a) Marksheet of T.Y.B.Sc. (If a student has failed in subject(s) previously, then all marksheets of B.Sc. should be uploaded in a single pdf file.)
 - b) Scan copy of applicant's passport size photograph and signature.
 - c) Aadhar Card.
 - d) Valid Caste Certificate must be uploaded, if applicable
 - e) If you are seeking admission through "Ex Serviceman, Defense, Sports and others Quota" or EWS etc. then relevant valid certificates are required
- 5) Form filled in the wrong category, or not filled completely or correctly, or not having the appropriate documents specified above will be rejected.
- 6) A General merit list will be prepared from the Online registration form

- submitted by all candidates and displayed on the College website and on the Department Notice board.
- 7) Admissions will be done strictly on the basis of merit as per the merit list and considering all rules, regulations and reservation policies of UGC, Government of Maharashtra and Savitribai Phule Pune University.
- 8) The admission rounds will be conducted in the <u>offline mode</u> on the college campus. The student/guardian must be present with all original relevant documents as per the date and timings specified in the admission schedule.
- 9) If the Candidate remains absent during the offline admission round then his/her admission claim stands cancelled.
