LOCATION AND BUILDINGS

Nowrosjee Wadia College of the Modern Education Society, Pune, is situated in a very strategic location, midway between the Pune Railway Station and Bund Garden.

The College has separate buildings for Arts and Science faculties. In addition to a three storeyed Golden Jubilee Building complex, a Diamond Jubilee building complex is utilised for post-graduate teaching and research. A new four storeyed building constructed in the college campus houses all sections of the Office under one roof. Moreover, the need for more classrooms, due to diversification and expansion will also be fulfilled. The College also has separate Assembly Hall, Boys' and Girls' Hostels, Mess, Canteen Hall and Gymnasium. An extensive area of about three hectares is used as a playground and a Gymkhana Pavilion built thereon is used both as a stadium and a gymnasium.

At present the College conducts Arts and Science courses of the Junior College, leading to B.A., B. Sc. and B. Sc. (Computer Sc.), B. Sc. (Biotechnology) degrees. Courses in M. A. in Economics, English, Geography and Psychology, M.Sc. in Physical Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Polymer Science, Organic Chemistry, Petroleum Technology, Physics, M.Sc. in Industrial Mathematics with Computer Applications / M. Sc. (Computer Sc.) / M. Sc. Botany / M. Sc. Electronics / M. Sc. Zoology / Masters in Computer Applications and B. Lib. Sc. The College has recognised research guides for M. Phil and Ph. D. on its roll. The Chemistry, Physics, Zoology, Geology and Geography laboratories have been recognised for research leading to M. Phil. and Ph.D. degrees.

ACCREDITATION AT 'A+' LEVEL– A HISTORICAL LANDMARK

A Peer Team of the National Council for Assessment and Accreditation (NAAC), Bangalore visited the College in October 2017 and accredited it with an 'A+' grade. This makes the College one of the few Colleges in Pune with an 'A+' grade. India Today has already ranked it second in Science stream in city wise ranking. These distinctions achieved by the College are a result of the hard work put in by its staff, the respectability its management enjoys in public and the support it has been receiving from the student community and alumni over all these years.

(A) JUNIOR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

(1) ADMISSION TO XI ARTS AND XII ARTS

(A) ALL THE ADMISSIONS OF STD. XI ARTS AND SCIENCE (AIDED AND UNAIDED) are carried out as per centralized on-line admission process as specified by the Deputy Director of Education, Pune Division, Pune.

(B) ADMISSION WITHOUT ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE OR DIRECT ADMISSION.

The following categories of students can be admitted without eligibility certificate at the time of admission to XI Arts on production of original marksheet and school leaving certificate :

- i) Students who have passed the 10 year S. S. C. Examination of the Maharashtra State Board.
- ii) Students who have passed the old S. S. C. Examination of M. S. B. S. E.

(C) ADMISSION SUBJECT TO ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE.

Students who have passed the S. S. C. or equivalent examination, e. g. I.C.S.E., C.B.S.E. etc. of any other statutory or recognised Board in India have to produce an eligibility certificate of M.S.B.S.S.H.S.E. at the time of admission. Students coming from abroad are also required to produce eligibility certificate of M.S.B.S.H.S.E. at the time of admission.

- 1) Admission to XII Arts is open to the students who have passed Annual Examination of XI Arts or XI Sc. or XI Com. Examination of a recognised institute. Is local transfer allowed?

(2) ADMISSION TO XI Sc. AND XII Sc.

Rules regarding direct admission and admission on production of eligibility certificate of M.S.B.S.H.S.E. are the same as mentioned above. However a student seeking admission to XI Science, must have offered Science Subjects such as General Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physiology Hygiene and other comparable science subjects in which the Board concerned holds examination and has secured minimum 40% marks in the Science Subjects.

Admission to XII Sc. is subject to passing of XI Sc. Examination of recognised institution. Students with XI Arts and XI Com. Certificates are not eligible for admission to XII Sc.

- 3) All admissions are subject to availability of seats and divisions as fixed by the Deputy Director of Education's Office and rules of centralised admission.

- 4) Local transfer from one educational institution to another is NOT permitted.

- 5) All admissions are temporary until finalised by M.S.B.S.H.S.E. An admission becomes formally finalised on satisfying the following conditions :

- (i) Admission Form is accompanied by Original Mark Sheet, School Leaving Certificate, Recent Passport size Photograph and Eligibility Certificate*

- (ii) Admission Form after verification is submitted to the office on the same day and confirming the admission by payment of prescribed fees and obtaining fee receipt thereof. Failing this a student will have to renew his admission, if available.

(*Students coming from other Board or Central School, Colleges and States / Countries will have to produce eligibility certificate of the M.S.B.S.H.S.E.)

- 6) No change of Subjects at Std. XI or at Std. XII is permitted and availability of subjects is as per capacity.

- 7) Notices regarding different subjects are to be read from notice boards of the respective departments.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR STUDENTS OF STD. XI (ARTS AND SCIENCE)

DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR, THE STUDENTS WILL HAVE TO APPEAR FOR

- (1) Two unit Tests / Tutorials
- (2) Terminal Examination
- (3) Annual Examination
- (4) Practical Examination
- (5) Orals in languages

Continuous assessment will be done through no space out the academic year in the form of Tutorials / Unit Tests.

The final result of the XI Science and Arts classes will be declared on the average of all the the above tests/examinations/orals including marks for regular attendance. Retest for Terminal and Annual Examinations will be arranged only for students on MEDICAL GROUNDS. (communicated prior to or during the examination and, who were unable to attend the examinations) There will be No Retest for any reasons other than Medical.

A student seeking admission for XI Arts and Science can join N. C. C.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR STUDENTS OF STD. XII (ARTS AND SCIENCE)

There will be a Preliminary Examination as per the H.S.C. Board pattern examination. Students from XII th Science and Arts must appear for this Examination. failing which their forms will not be sent to the H.S.C. Board. For Science students, there will be Preliminary Practical Test before the H.S.C. Board Practical Examination. Only those students who pass in the Preliminary Examination will be allowed to appear for Preliminary practical test.

(C) FEES AND REFUNDS

Students whose admission has been approved by the College authorities have to pay their fees immediately as per Fee schedule announced on the Notice boards. Information regarding fee concessions and such other matters is also mentioned there. For fee concessions and refund of fees, students concerned are advised to see the Notice Board regularly or approach the College Office.

(D) FEE CONCESSIONS

The following freeship concessions are available at this college.

- (a) Economically backward class freeship
- (b) Freeship to the sons / daughters of primary school teachers.
- (c) Freeship to the sons and daughters of secondary school teachers and non teaching staff.
- (d) Scholarship to sons, grand-sons, daughters and grand-daughters of Goa Mukti.
- (e) Freeship to sons and daughters of defence service personnel and ex-servicemen.
- (f) Maharashtra Government's freeship to girl students in Junior College.
- (g) Physically Handicapped Scholarship is available to the concerned students.

Procedure for availing G.O.I. Scholarship / freeship belonging to S.C. / S.T. / N.T. / V.J. / SBC / OBC Categories - Maharashtra State.

- (1) GOI Scholarship to students of above mentioned categories whose parental Income is less than Rs. 2,50,000/- P.A. for SC/ST category and Rs. 1,00,000/- P.A. for NT/SBC/OBC/VJ category.
- (2) Freeship for SC/ST/VJ/NT/SBC/OBC is available.
- (3) The forms should be submitted to the scholarship section with necessary documents within 15 days after admission in Jr. College (online).
- (4) The College fees will be recovered from concerned student if the concession form is not submitted in time to the college office. For details, student should contact the Scholarships Counter and see the scholarship Notice Board regularly.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- (1) Students who desire to claim any one of the fees concessions, may do so by filling in the prescribed concession form one month after admission every year; failing which the college fees will be recovered from the student.
- (2) Students are advised to see the notices with respect to Scholarships regularly.
- (3) As per the Govt. notifications, the Govt. of India B.C. Scholarship holders will receive their scholarship by crossed cheque only.
- (4) The freeship is applicable to the children of such Ex-Servicemen who are domiciled in Maharashtra State or recruited in Maharashtra and retired from defence service and at the time of retirement holding rank upto Major or its equivalent cadres or below, rank in Navy and Air Force. They should submit the eligibility from D.S.S. Board or ZillaSainik Board within one month after the admission to the College Office.
- (5) Freeship to the sons and daughters of Teaching and Non-Teaching staff who are in Service of Government aided and recognised Secondary School and Junior College is available. Freeship will be available only for two children.

(E) OTHER FACILITIES

Junior College students are extended all facilities like library, gymkhana, mess and canteen, students activities, academic prizes and hostels along with the Degree College students.

(F) CASTE VALIDITY CERTIFICATE

(XI Science and XI Arts Students)

The students belonging to reserved categories i.e. S.C. / S.T. / V.J. / N.T. / S.B.C. / OBC and who desire to join professional courses i.e. Medical / Engineering and B.Ed. etc. after XII Std. are required to submit their applications in the prescribed form along with the necessary documents in the college office (Scholarship counter) before 25th of October of that year to obtain the caste validity certificate.
